Shepherd Booster Club is offering two- \$1,000 general scholarships.

Guidelines

1. The applicant or the dependent applicant's parent/guardian is currently a member of Shepherd Booster Club. The applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
2. The applicant must be a student who is enrolled or planning to enroll in a full time undergraduate course of study at an accredited college or university for the upcoming fall term.
3. Include one letter of reference:
 - (a.) From Shepherd High School faculty members (i.e. teachers, coaches, principal, counselor, etc.)
4. Must describe your involvement in activities during your years attending Shepherd High School, including out of school activities, jobs, volunteering, community activities, school spirit, leadership, etc. Please include description of times you or your parents assisted Shepherd Booster Club.
5. Scholarships are based on the following criteria:
 - (a.) Leadership - including school and community activities, awards, honors and work experience **50%**
 - (b.) Personal statement of 250 words about how your leadership, school and community activities will influence your career goals **50 %**
6. The completed scholarship application is due to the Shepherd High School office by **April 1, 2017**. The decision will be made with notification to the student. If the recipient is a graduating senior, the school will announce the name at graduation or an award's assembly.
7. To collect award, please drop off a copy of the student's first semester of college grades and a copy of the student's spring schedule with the name and address of the school attending in the Booster mail box of the high school or Box 215, Shepherd, MT 59079
8. ONE alternate will be identified in the event one scholarship recipient is not able to use the funds.
